## COMMON SERVICE CENTRES

# **3101. SHRI PRADYUT BORDOLOI:**

Will the Minister of ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Common Service Centres (CSCs) functional at the Gram Panchayat level, Statewise including the North Eastern Region (NER);

(b) the number of CSCs which were closed/shut down after becoming functional, State-wise particularly in the NER and the common reasons therefor;

(c) the average income of the Village Level Entrepreneurs (VLEs) in charge of CSCs, Statewise particularly for the NER;

(d) the average internet speed available in CSCs, State-wise particularly in the NER and the national average for the same; and

(e) the number of transactions carried out via CSCs in the NER during the last five years?

#### ANSWER

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) to (e): Common Services Centre (CSC) programme is an initiative of Government of India for enabling easy access to services for citizens. CSCs are the access points for delivery of various services to citizens. CSCs are operated by village level entrepreneurs. CSC e-Governance Services India Limited, acts as a coordinating agency to enable on boarding and delivery of services centrally through its Digital Seva technology platform.

CSC e-Governance Services India Limited has apprised that as on 31.01.2025, a total of 5,97,441 CSCs are operational across the country, with 4,73,357 CSCs functioning at the Gram Panchayat (GP) level. State wise status of CSC Rollout as on Jan 2025 including North Eastern Region (NER), is at **Annexure-I.** The number of transactions carried out via CSCs in the NER is provided in **Annexure II.** 

CSC e-Governance Services India Limited has apprised that a total of 13,664 CSCs across the country including NER have been closed due to various reasons, including operational and administrative challenges such as low footfall, sustainability and reliability of stable internet connectivity. The status in respect of closed CSCs in NER is at **Annexure-III**.

Further, CSC SPV has apprised that VLEs (Village Level Entrepreneurs) operating CSCs are entrepreneurs and their income is dependent on the services provided by them and local demand, for which they receive a prescribed amount of commission for delivery of services. The revenue-sharing between CSC SPV and VLEs is in the ratio 20:80. It may be noted that no monetary support is provided by the CSC SPV to the VLEs. Further, VLEs choose various speeds from various Internet service provider as per requirement and availability for the functioning of the CSC centers.
