THEFT OF TELEPHONE CABLE

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether incidents of telephone-cable theft have been reported from various parts of the Country;

(b) if so, the State-wise details thereof during the last three years and the current year; and

(c) the steps taken by the Government to curb the said incidents of cable theft along with the results thereof?

(a) to (c) The telephone-cable theft incidences reported from various parts of the country by Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) & Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited (MTNL) are attached as **Annexure-I**.

BSNL & MTNL have taken following measures to curb the incidents of cable theft:

- i. Coordination with civic agencies involved in digging works.
- ii. Lodging of FIR.
- iii. Precautionary patrolling along the cable route.

As a result of above measures, the number of incidents of cable theft have been reduced.
