Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the long-standing demand for a direct train service between Jind-Ringas (Khatu Shyamji) and Jind-Haridwar;**
- (b) if so, the reasons for not having a direct train service between these two cities inspite of heavy demand of passengers;**
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any feasibility study or received proposals for introducing a direct train service on this route; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, whether the Government plans to start a direct train service at the earliest?**

(a) to (d) Passengers of Jind desirous of travelling to Ringas (Khatu Shyamji) and Haridwar may avail changeover at Delhi for their onwards journey. Delhi is very well connected to Ringas by 06 pairs and to Haridwar by 18 pairs of train services. Besides, Delhi is also connected to Jind by 19 pairs of train services. Moreover, introduction of new train services is an on-going process on Indian Railway subject to operational feasibility, traffic justification, competing demands, etc.
