### †3224. SHRI RAJKUMAR ROAT:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of villages selected so far under the Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan (PMJUGA) in tribal-dominated areas along with the number of villages benefited and yet to be benefited, State-wise;

(b) whether the tribal communities are provided with health, education, skill development and infrastructure development under the said abhiyaan and if so, the details thereof;

(c) the number of works undertaken under the said abhiyaan in Dungarpur-Banswara of Banswara Parliamentary Constituency, gram panchayat-wise; and

(d) whether the Government proposes to expand the coverage of the said abhiyaan by increasing the budget and if so, the details thereof?

### ANSWER

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI DURGADAS UIKEY)

(a) to (c) Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan (name as per budget announcment 2024-25) has been launched as Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan by Hon'ble PM on 2nd October, 2024. The Abhiyan comprises of 25 interventions implemented by 17 line Ministries and aims to saturate infrastructural gaps in 63,843 villages, improve access to health, education, Anganwadi facilities and providing livelihood opportunities benefiting more than 5 crore tribals in 549 districts and 2,911 blocks in 30 States/UTs in 5 years including 1538 villages in Banswara Parliamentary Constituency. The State/UT-wise coverage of villages under this Abhiyan is at **Annexure-I**. Each Ministry has been allocated budget and targets under Abhiyan and responsible for implementing the intervention assigned to it. The Abhiyan aims at Saturation through convergence and outreach. The actual coverage of beneficiaries in a particular to the States / UTs including Rajasthan is subject to meeting eligibility criteria of specific guidelines of concerned interventions. The details of activities approved by Ministry of Tribal Affairs in Banswara and Dungarpur districts based on the proposals of State Government of Rajasthan under the abhiyan are at **Annexure-II**. Further, as per information from Ministry of Jal Shakti, out of total coverage of 1698 villages in Banswara and Dungarpur districts, 149 villages have been saturated for drinking water supply. Ministry of Rural Development has

sanctioned 27789 awas in Banswara district and 19582 awas in Dungarpur district. Ministry of Women and Child Development has sanctioned 7 AWCs in Banswara district and 3 AWCs in Dungarpur district

(d) The abhiyan has been launched on 2nd October, 2024 and is for the period of 5 years from 2024-25 to 2028-29 with budgetary outlay of Rs.79,156 Cr (Central share: ₹56,333 Cr and State share: ₹22,823 Cr).
