- (a) A total of 40181 trees (approx.) is planned to be felled for the expansion of National Highway (NH)-17. The tree felling activities are being carried out by the Forest Department, Government of Assam and National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. (NHIDCL) has deposited the requisite amount for the felling of trees.
- (b) Compensatory afforestation in lieu of trees felled is to be carried out by the Forest Department of Government of Assam out of the funds deposited by NHIDCL for the purpose.
