CONSTRUCTION OF BED DAM AT GODDAR AND PALAR RIVERS

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has sanctioned any funds for the protection and preservation of River Palar, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;

(b) whether the Government has contributed any funds for the construction of the first bed dam at the confluence of the Goddar and Palar rivers at Erayangadu village in Vellore for the benefit of farmers in Anaicut and K.V. Kuppam regions in Vellore Parliamentary Constituency and if so, the details thereof; and (c) whether the Government has any plans to support the construction of more bed dams to restore lost river sand and discharge excess rainwater to dry portions of the river and if so, the details thereof?

(a) The Government of Tamil Nadu has sanctioned the fund to preserve the river Palar for the following works in the year 2021-2022, 2022-2023 and 2023-2024.

(b) The Government of Tamil Nadu has contributed the fund to the construction of bed dam across Palar River near Eraiyangadu Village in Anicut and K. V. Kuppam Taluks of Vellore District for Rs. 52.48 Crores.

This scheme envisage bifurcation of the river water proportionately towards Palar and Goddar rivers. This scheme also envisage to enrich the ground water in surrounding 12 villages in both sides of the Palar river and Goddar river, to recharge 12 infiltration wells and to benefit 1379.49 hectares of agricultural lands through 626 irrigation wells. It envisage to benefit 7642 farmers directly and 75000 persons indirectly.

(c) The Water Resources Department of Government of Tamil Nadu has planned to construct following check dams, Anicut and barrages across Palar river.
