### **MONETIZATION OF NHs**

#### **3355. SHRI NAVEEN JINDAL:**

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS सडक परिवहन और राजमार्ग मंत्री

be pleased to state:

(a) the total length of the National Highways (NHs) in the country;

(b) the length of NHs monetized thus far along with the revenue earned; and

(c) the steps taken by the Government to ensure proper maintenance, timely and effective assistance in case of any exigencies and emergencies on the NHs monetized so far?

#### ANSWER

(a) The total length of National Highways (NHs) in the country is 1,46,204 Kms.

(b) The length that has been monetized and the revenue earned through Asset Monetization Mode from Financial Year 2019-20 to Financial Year 2024-25 (15.3.2025) are as under:

Mode	Length (km)	Revenue (Rs. in Cr.)
Toll-Operate-Transfer (TOT)	2565	48995
Infrastructure Investiment Tust (InvIT)	1523	25900
Toll Securitization	1277	50125
TOTAL	5365	125020

(c) As per the relevant clauses of the Model Concessionaire Agreement (MCA), the Concessionaire is to ensure proper maintenance, timely and effective assistance on the NHs. Clause 15 of the MCA of TOT model provides for "Operation and Maintenance" of NHs by National Highways Authority of India (NHAI), Clause 16 of the MCA of TOT model provides for "Monitoring of Operation and Maintenance" of NHs and Clause 18 of the MCA of TOT model provides for "Safety Requirements" of NHs. Regional Offices of NHAI monitor the adherence to contractual clauses.
