# CURRENT STATUS OF JJM IN CHHATTISGARH

#### †3373. SHRI SANTOSH PANDEY:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

(a) the current status of the Jal Jeevan Mission in Chhattisgarh, district-wise;

(b) the total funds allocated to Chhattisgarh under the JJM since its inception till date;

(c) the details of the total number of households provided with tap water in all districts of Rajnandgaon Parliamentary Constituency of Chhattisgarh under the said mission, block-wise; and

(d) whether any timeline has been set and additional funds have been allocated for achieving hundred percent tap water availability to the households under the said mission and if so, the details thereof?

#### ANSWER

#### MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI V. SOMANNA)

(a) The district-wise status of tap water supply in Chhattisgarh, as reported by the State Government, is placed at **annex - 1**.

(b) As on 17.03.2025, a total amount of Rs. 10,549.37 Crore has been allocated to Chhattisgarh since the inception of JJM and out of which, the State has drawn a total of Rs. 6,178.33 Crore only.

(c) As reported by the State Government, the block-wise details of total number of households provided with tap water in all districts of Rajnandgaon Parliamentary Constituency of Chhattisgarh is placed at **annex - 2**.

(d) Hon'ble Finance Minister during her budget speech 2025- 26 has announced extension of Jal Jeevan Mission until 2028.
