be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to expand National Highway-07 (NH-07), which connects Mirzapur and Prayagraj, into a four-lane or six-lane highway and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has issued tenders for the widening of NH-07 and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the estimated expenditure for this project?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs) including NHs in the State of Uttar Pradesh is a continuous process. Works on NHs are accordingly taken up depending upon traffic density, requirement of connectivity, inter-se priority and synergy with PM Gati Shakti framework to keep the NHs in traffic worthy conditions.

Prayagraj is connected to Mirzapur by NH-35. The Government has taken up preparation of Detailed project report (DPR) for upgradation of NH-35 to 4 lane NH standards between Prayagraj and Mirzapur.

The National Highway (Old NH-07) connecting Varanasi and Hanumana (UP/MP Border) via Mirzapur has already been upgraded to 4 lane NH configurations.
