PROMOTION OF TRADITIONAL INDUSTRIES

3448. SHRI BRIJENDRA SINGH OLA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing the Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI) scheme for the upgradation and promotion of traditional industries across the country including in Jhunjhunu district of Rajasthan, if so, the details thereof.
- (b) the details on the outcomes of this scheme so far.
- (c) whether the Government has undertaken efforts for the promotion of traditional industries such as Bandhej in Shekhawati region in Rajasthan including Jhunjhunu district and if so, the number of industries and organized artisan groups in Jhunjhunu district and other districts of Rajasthan; and
- (d) whether the Government is making efforts to provide continuous employment to artisans in rural areas and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE

- (a): Yes, the Government is implementing SFURTI for the upgradation and promotion of traditional industries across the country including in Jhunjhunu district of Rajasthan. As on date, 513 clusters have been approved under the scheme including the Kolsiya Tie & Dye Cluster, in Jhunjhunu District of Rajasthan, with Government of India(GoI) assistance of ₹275.6 lakhs, benefiting 349 artisans.
- (b): As on date, 513 clusters have been approved under SFURTI with a total GoI assistance of Rs. 1,334 crores directly benefitting around 3.00 lakh artisans. Out of 513 approved clusters, 68 clusters are all women artisan clusters, 62 are all SC/ST artisan clusters and 87 clusters are in the North Eastern Region (NER). Out of the approved clusters, 376 clusters have functional.
- (c): Yes, the Government has undertaken efforts to promote traditional industries including Bandhej in the Sikar, Jhunjhunu, and Churu Districts of Shekhawati region in Rajasthan. A total of 1034 traditional artisans are supported through 3 clusters, one each in the Sikar, Jhunjhunu, and Churu Districts besides, conducting soft interventions including Entrepreneurship & Skill Development Programme (ESDP). Details of clusters approved in all the Districts of Rajasthan are attached as **Annexure-I.**
- (d): Yes, the Government is making continuous effort to provide continuous employment to traditional artisans in rural areas across the country in the 513 approved clusters.
