### NATIONAL POLICY FOR HEALTHCARE OF ELDERLY

3466: DR. RANI SRIKUMAR

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount of funds allocated for National Policy for Healthcare of Elderly (NPHCE) in the country during the last five years, year-wise and State/UT-wise including Tamil Nadu;
- (b) the details of the Regional Geriatric Centres (RGCs) established in the country during the last five years, year-wise, State/UT-wise and district-wise for Tamil Nadu;
- (c) the details of the elderly person who have benefited from the Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana during the last five years, State/UT-wise and year-wise; and
- (d) whether the initiatives taken by the Government to ensure the availability of healthcare facilities in rural areas for the elderly have been successful, if so, the details thereof?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) to (d): The amount of funds allocated for National Policy for Healthcare of Elderly (NPHCE) in the country during the last five years, year-wise and State/UT-wise including Tamil Nadu is placed at **Annexure I**. The details of the Regional Geriatric Centres (RGCs) established in the country, year-wise, State/UT-wise and district-wise for Tamil Nadu is at **ANNEXURE-II**.

States/UTs wise and Year wise number of hospital admissions of elderly persons (Age 60 years and above) under AB PM-JAY in the last five years is at **Annexure-III**.

The Government of India had launched 'National Programme for Health Care of the Elderly (NPHCE)' in 2010-11 to address various health related issues of elderly. The programme is implemented throughout the country including rural areas. Healthcare services provided at Sub centres are Health Education related to healthy ageing, environmental modifications, nutritional requirements, life styles and behavioural changes.

Special attention is paid to home bound/ bedridden elderly persons and to provide training to the family health care providers looking after the disabled elderly persons. At Primary Health Centre weekly geriatric clinic is arranged by a trained Medical Officer (MO). At Community Health Centre biweekly geriatric Clinic and Rehabilitation services are arranged by trained staff and rehabilitation worker. Domiciliary visits by rehabilitation worker is under taken for bed-ridden elderly and counseling of family members for taking care of elderly is done. At District Hospitals dedicated Geriatric OPD services, In-door admissions in District Hospitals having 10 bedded geriatric ward, laboratory investigations and rehabilitation services are provided. Elderly patients are referred to District Hospitals by CHCs/PHCs etc. whenever required and severe cases are referred to tertiary level hospitals.
