HIGH CHARGES FOR US GOLD CARD SCHEME FOR IMMIGRANTS 3615. SHRI JAI PRAKASH

 President Donald Trump's announcement about raising all time high

(a & b) On February 25, 2025, President Donald J. Trump announced that the U.S. intends to sell "Gold Cards" that will provide the recipient with U.S. lawful permanent residency privileges as well as a path to U.S. citizenship in exchange for a \$5 million fee. The President also

made a reference to the "Gold Cards" scheme in his address to a joint session of the U.S. Congress on 5th March 2025. However, the guidelines for the scheme are yet to be published.
