Decrease in Grants to States by 16th Finance Commission

3795. Adv Dean Kuriakose:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the 16th Finance Commission has decided to bring down the percentage share of devolution of funds from the Centre to the States from 41% to 40%;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the number of States had requested to increase the share of Centre from 41% to 50% and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the percentage of taxes that are contributed from the State of Kerala and the subsequent amounts collected from Kerala during the last five years; and
- (e) the total amount of funds sanctioned by the Government to the State Government of Kerala during the last five years as a part of the devolution?
