**Permanent and Temporary Employees in Government Schools
of Daman and Diu**

3889. Shri Patel Umeshbhai Babubhai :

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the number of students in Government Primary, Upper Primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary schools in Daman and Diu, category-wise;
- (b) the number of temporary and permanent Government employees in the said schools, category and school-wise;
- (c) the number of permanent Headmasters/Principals in Government schools of Daman and Diu;
- (d) the reasons for not having permanent Principals/Headmasters in all the schools; and
- (e) the time by which permanent appointment on the said posts are likely to be made in these schools?

(a): The details of the number of students in Government Primary, Upper Primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary schools in Daman and Diu, category-wise are given below :

Higher Secondary (IX to XII)	1692

(b) The number of temporary and permanent Government employees in the said schools, category and school-wise is given below :

Category	Permanent	Temporary	Total
Primary (I to V)	150	107	257
Upper Primary (I to VIII)	29	117	146
Secondary (IX to X)	121	59	180
Higher Secondary (IX to XII)	34	18	52
Total	334	301	635

(c) to (e) The number of sanctioned posts of Principal/Headmaster are 13. Education being a subject in the Concurrent List of the Constitution, an overwhelming majority of the schools in the country comes under the administrative control of States/UTs. The recruitment, service conditions and rational deployment of teachers come under the purview of the respective State Governments/UT Administrations. Recruitment is a continuous process and vacancies arise due to a number of factors like retirement, resignation, increased requirement of teachers because of the enhanced students' strength etc.
