AGRICULTURAL LAND AFFECTED BY FLOODS

4064. SHRI UTKARSH VERMA MADHUR:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

(a) the State-wise details of total area of agricultural land affected by floods annually;

(b) whether any new technique has been developed for affected agricultural areas; and

(c) if so, the details thereof as many areas still continue to be affected by floods over the years?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Details of agricultural land affected by floods is not maintained centrally. However, as reported by the State Governments/ Union Territories, the details of the cropped area affected due to hydro-meteorological calamities, including flood, during 2024-25 (as on 18.03.2025), are at Annexure.

Indian Council of Agricultural Research had suggested land modification (alternate raised and furrow bed system), integrated farming system with agroforestry, cultivation of flood-tolerant paddy varieties (i.e. Hangseswari, Sabita, etc.), water chestnut, makhana for flood affected areas and also use of over-aged rice seedlings for post-flood management. In addition, 651 district agricultural contingency plans have been developed for preparedness and implementation in the events of weather aberrations and extreme climatic events including flood.
