- (a) the details of the plans of the Government for overall development of rural areas; and
- (b) the steps taken by the Government to resolve the poverty free villages for poverty free India?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) is implementing a number of welfare schemes/programmes such as Mahatma Gandhi Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Pradhan MantriAwaasYojana-Gramin (PMAYG), Pradhan Mantri Gram SadakYojana (PMGSY), DeendayalAntyodayaYojana - National Rural Mission Livelihoods (DAY-NRLM), DeenDayalUpadhyayaGrameenKaushalyaYojana (DDUGKY), Rural Self Employment Training Institutes(RSETIs) and National Social Assistance **Programme (NSAP) and Watershed** Component (WDC) of the Pradhan MantriKrishiSinchayeeYojana (WDC-PMKSY) for overall development of rural areas of the country. These schemes/programmes aim to alleviate poverty and to bring about overall improvement in the quality of life of the people in rural areas of the country by strengthening livelihood opportunities, minimum guaranteed employment, promoting employment, skilling of youths in various useful trades and entrepreneurship qualities, infrastructure development and provision of social assistance.

Further, in the budget for the Financial Year (FY) 2025–26, the Government has announced the launch of a comprehensive multisectoral 'Rural Prosperity and Resilience' programme. The programme aims to address underemployment in agriculture through skilling, investment, technology and invigorating the rural economy. The focus will be on rural women, young farmers, rural youth, marginal and small farmers and landless families with goal to generate ample opportunities in rural areas.
