4090. SHRI APPALANAIDU KALISSETTI:

Will the Minister of **COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total funds allocated, released, and utilized under the Footwear, Leather, and Accessories Development Programme (FLADP) since its approval, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of projects approved and implemented under each component of FLADP, including the Integrated Development of Leather Sector (IDLS), Mega Leather Footwear and Accessories Cluster Development (MLFACD), Sustainable Technology and Environmental Promotion (STEP), Establishment of Institutional Facilities (EIF), Brand Promotion and Development of Design Studios;
- (c) the number of leather clusters and footwear manufacturing units that have benefited under the scheme, State/UT-wise;
- (d) whether the Government has received any proposals from Andhra Pradesh for projects under FLADP and if so, the details thereof and current status of such proposals; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to enhance the global competitiveness of the Indian leather and footwear industry through this scheme?

- (a): The Government of India has approved the Central Sector Scheme 'Indian Footwear and Leather Development Programme (IFLDP)' with an allocation of Rs.1700 crore for the period of 2021-26 or till further review, whichever is earlier. As on 17.03.2025, ₹ 812.69 crore has been released under the scheme. Project wise, State wise details are given at Annexures I and II referred to in answers to para (b) and (c) of the question.

(b): Indian Footwear and Leather Development Programme (IFLDP) is being implemented with six sub-schemes which are as under:

- i. Sustainable Technology and Environmental Promotion (STEP)
- ii. Brand Promotion of Indian Brands in Leather and Footwear Sector (BPIBLFS)
- iii. Development of Design Studios (DDS)
- iv. Mega Leather Footwear and Accessories Cluster Development (MLFACD)
- v. Establishment of Institutional Facilities (EIF)
- vi. Integrated Development of Leather Sector (IDLS)

588 units have been benefited under IDLS sub-scheme with Government of India (GoI) assistance of Rs.394.09 crore and details of project approved under all other sub-schemes are placed at Annexure-I.

(c): 5 projects have been approved under MLFACD sub-scheme of IFLDP. As per National Single Window System (NSWS) portal of the Department, 473 units have benefited under footwear & footwear component of IDLS sub-scheme. The state wise details are placed at Annexure-II.

(d): Two proposals/units were received for tanneries component under IDLS sub-scheme of IFLDP from Andhra Pradesh and financial assistance has been provided.

(e): IFLDP scheme enhances the competitiveness of the leather and footwear industry by supporting various aspects like, infrastructure, technology upgradation, branding, sustainability etc of the sector. The scheme focuses on:

- Upgradation/modernization of tanneries, footwear & footwear components units, leather goods and accessories units, harness & saddlery manufacturing units.
- Assisting leather clusters to meet the prescribed pollution control discharge norms by establishing or upgrading existing Common Effluent Treatment Plants (CETPs).
- Developing Mega Leather Footwear and Accessories to create world-class infrastructure and integrating the production chain of the leather and footwear industry so as to cater to the domestic market and exports.
- For global recognition, extending international branding support to leading Indian manufacturers in footwear and leather sector while establishing brands as Assets and enabling them achieve higher valuations for their products.
- Establishing design studios for the sector which aims to play a pro- active role in the strategy to mesh markets with entrepreneurs and to catalyze the technological transformation of the sector.
- Establishing and upgrading the infrastructure of campuses of Footwear Design and Development Institute (FDDI) for strengthening the sector with the skilled manpower.
