Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- a) the steps being taken by the Government to support the growth of the AVGC-XR (Animation, Visual Effects, Gaming and Comics along with Augmented Reality/Virtual Reality and the Metaverse) sector in India in line with initiatives like the "Road to Game Jam":
- b) whether the Government is considering to provide financial assistance, tax incentives or grants for young game developers and startups participating in such competitions and if so, the details thereof; and
- c) whether there are any plans to introduce a national-level AVGC-XR policy to promote India as a global hub for gaming and immersive technologies and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR INFORMATION & BROADCASTING AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (DR. L. MURUGAN)

(a): In a significant step toward making India a global hub for AVGC(Animation, Visual Effects, Gaming and Comics), the Union Cabinet has approved the establishment of Indian Institute of Creative Technology (IICT) in Mumbai.

IICT is registered as a section 8 company under the Companies Act, 2013. The Ministry has sanctioned Rs. 391.15 crore for setting up of IICT, Mumbai.

Further, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting is organizing World Audio-Visual & Entertainment Summit (WAVES) 2025, focused on broadcasting, digital media, AVGC-XR, and films. The WAVES, 2025 in its first edition is a unique platform poised for the convergence of the entire global Media and Entertainment (M&E) sector.

- (b): The challenge 'Road to Game Jam' is one of the challenges under 'Create in India Challenge (CIC) Season 1' which is supported by Government of India. CIC has been launched as a precursor to the World Audio Visual & Entertainment Summit (WAVES) 2025 with the Grand Finale to be hosted during WAVES 2025 from 1st May 4th May 2025.
- (c): A dedicated AVGC Task Force was constituted in April 2022 to devise a strategic framework for development of this sector. The AVGC Task Force submitted its report to the Ministry in December 2022, with the recommendation to support the AVGC-XR sector in a mission-mode approach.
