(ii) Employability skill for Persons with Disabilities.

These programs enable Persons with Disability to seek employment by imparting requisite skill training.

(b) & (c) National Institutes and Composite Regional Centres (CRCs) make continuous efforts to collaborate with industries and organizations to enhance employment opportunities for skilled Persons with Disabilities (PwDs). Additionally, the Department has developed the PM-DAKSH portal, where PwDs can register to seek employment, while industry partners can list job opportunities.
