BHARATMALA PROJECTS IN CHHATTISGARH

4385. SHRI VIJAY BAGHEL:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of the expressway being constructed under the Bharatmala project from Durg to Raipur via Arang in Durg district of Chhattisgarh;**
- (b) the timeline by which this six-lane road is expected to be completed;**
- (c) the number of locations in the Durg Parliamentary Constituency where connecting/approach road facilities to the expressway are being provided; and**
- (d) whether more connecting/approach roads are proposed to be completed on requirement in the public interest, if so, the details thereof, location-wise?**

ANSWER

(a) and (b) The construction of the 6-lane greenfield highway from Durg to Arang, spanning 92.23 km, is currently in progress. The section within Durg district covers 40.70 km and has achieved a physical progress of 28.55% with revised scheduled date for completion of project as 30.06.2026.

(c) The following two locations in Durg parliamentary constituency have been provided with interchange facilities, along with connecting/approach road provisions:

- i. Interchange at Km 8+720 – Durg-Balod (SH7) crossroad (near CSIT Durg).**
- ii. Interchange at Km 34+750 – Durg-Patan (SH22) crossroad (near village Funda).**

(d) No such proposal is under consideration at this stage.
