ALLOCATION AND DISBURSEMENT OF SUBSIDY UNDER PM-FME

4388. PROF. VARSHA EKNATH GAIKWAD:

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SHRI SANJAY DINA PATIL:

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Will the Minister of *FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the total amount of subsidy allocated and disbursed to various States including Maharashtra under the Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PM-FME) Scheme;
- (b) the total subsidy amount released under the PM-FME scheme, State-wise including Maharashtra;
- (c) the amount of allocated subsidy disbursed to the micro food processing enterprises in each State and the percentage of funds utilized so far;
- (d) the manner in which the Government monitors and evaluates the effectiveness of subsidy utilization by the micro food processing enterprises in each State;
- (e) whether the Government has conducted any assessment on the impact of these subsidies on the micro food processing sectors in Maharashtra and if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) whether there has been any delay in the release of subsidies to Maharashtra or other States under the PM-FME scheme and if so, the details thereof and the steps being taken to address these issues?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI RAVNEET SINGH)

- (a): Centre Share of Rs. 2704.61 Cr. has been released to States/ UTs for implementation of various components of Pradhan Mantri Formalization of Micro food processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme, out of which an amount of Rs. 401.04 crores have been released to the State of Maharashtra till 28th February 2025.
- **(b) & (c):** An amount of Rs. 2085.37 Crores has been released as Centre Share towards credit linked subsidy including Rs. 422.77 Crores to the State of Maharashtra as per the details at details at **Annexure-I**. About 94.82 % of the funds have been utilized as on 28th February 2025.
- (d): The effectiveness of implementation of the scheme is monitored by respective lending Banks and State Nodal Departments/agencies of respective State / UT Governments.
- (e): Assessment on the impact of subsidies on the micro food processing sectors in Maharashtra has not been conducted by Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) so far.
- **(f):** There is no delay in releasing Centre share of subsidies to Maharashtra or other States under the PM-FME scheme. However, there is some delays on the part of States/UTs in withdrawal of corresponding State Share of funds from the State Treasury thereby delaying the release of subsidy to end beneficiaries.
