Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

- (a) the total number of passengers who travelled on domestic air routes during 2024, airline wise and quarter-wise along with the comparative data for the corresponding period in 2023;
- (b) whether the Government has conducted any analysis regarding the factors contributing to the changes in domestic passenger traffic and if so, the findings thereof;
- (c) the total number of passengers who travelled on international air routes during 2024, country-wise and airline-wise along with the comparative data for the corresponding period in 2023;
- (d) whether the Government has made any projections regarding passenger traffic growth for the upcoming year and if so, the details thereof along with the steps being taken to accommodate the projected traffic;
- (e) the details of air traffic from various airports of the country along with the new airports proposed to be developed under UDAN 2.0 scheme; and

(f) the total number of passengers arrived in Prayagraj by flights during Mahakumbh along with the number of new flights that were scheduled for Mahakumbh from different cities?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The quarter-wise data of domestic passengers handled, airline-wise during 2024 as compared to 2023 is given at Annexure.;

Country wise, Airline wise passenger carried by Scheduled Indian and Foreign operators for Scheduled International operations for Calendar Year 2023 & 2024 is available on the DGCA website at Table 7.06 https://www.dgca.gov.in/digigov-portal/?page=yearly/4267/9450/html&mainundefined

As per Airports Authority of India estimates, the domestic and total passenger traffic is expected to reach around 590 and 715 million respectively by the year 2029-30.;

To improve the aviation infrastructure to facilitate air passengers in the country, Airports Authority of India(AAI) had embarked upon a CAPEX plan of 23000 Crores during 5 years (2025-29) for development/upgradation / modernization of various airports in the country to meet the requirement of Air traffic /passengers growth which includes New Airports, expansions/ Modification of existing terminal, addition of new passenger facilities, New terminals, expansions/ strengthening of existing runways, aprons, ANS work like control tower, technical block etc.

- (e): The government has also announced launching of a modified UDAN Scheme for the next 10 years aimed at connecting 120 new destinations. The scheme will also support helipads and smaller airports in hilly, aspirational and North East region districts. The scheme is presently at formulation stage.
- (f) :During Mahakumbh (13th January, 2025 to 26th February, 2025), 5.43 Lakh Passengers were handled on 3394 flights by Scheduled Airlines, at Prayagraj Airport.
