- (a) the details of funds allocated by the Government for PM-Adi Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAAGY);
- (b) the total number of tribal villages, to be developed under the said scheme, State-wise, particularly in Shahdol Parliamentary Constituency;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps to address health infrastructure in tribal villages; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI DURGADAS UIKEY)

- (a) to (b): Government has approved implementation of the scheme of 'Pradhan Mantri Adi Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAAGY)' with a total outlay of Rs. 7276.00 crore for 36,428 Villages. Under the Scheme of 'Pradhan Mantri Adi Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAAGY) the total 17,656 Village Development Plans have been approved across country and total funds allocated to Rs.3476.88 Cr. The details of total 36,428 villages state wise identified under Pradhan Mantri Adi Adrash Gram Yojana (PMAAGY) is at Annexure-I. The district wise details of the villages in the State of Madhya Pradesh including the Shahdol Parliamentary Constituency under PMAAGY is at Annexure-II.
- (c) & (d): The PMAAGY scheme's primary objective is to use a convergence method to accomplish integrated socioeconomic development of selected number of villages. Road connectivity (internal and inter-village/block), telecom connectivity (mobile/internet), schools, anganwadi centers, health sub-centers, drinking water facilities, drainage, and solid waste management are the eight development sectors where the Scheme aims to significantly reduce gaps. This schemes address the gaps with regard to basic amenities identified through Antodaya Mission, including health infrastructure in each selected village.
