SHARING OF HOTEL ROOMS DURING LAYOVERS

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the announcement by Air India for compulsorily sharing the hotel rooms by most of its cabin crew during layovers especially during long-haul flights has sparked concern over their need for rest and privacy; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the corrective steps being taken by the Government along with the results yielded therefrom?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Air India provides single occupancy rooms to all the Senior Cabin Crew.

For Cabin Crew, Air India provides single occupancy rooms during layovers after ultra-long-haul flights and during unscheduled layovers at international offline stations due to flight diversions. For all other destinations dual occupancy rooms are provided.
