PROMOTION OF KHADI AND VILLAGE INDUSTRIES

4456. SHRI BRIJENDRA SINGH OLA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the development of Khadi and Village Industries has declined during the last three years and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has taken steps to promote khadi and village industries and provide financial assistance to artisans in rural and small towns during the last three years and if so, the details thereof, year and district-wise in Rajasthan particularly in Jhunjhunu district;
- (c) the details of khadi products exported during the said period and the domestic and foreign exchange earned from them, year-wise; and
- (d) the steps being taken by the Government to further promote the export of khadi products?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

(a): No sir. The development of Khadi and Village Industries (KVI) has not declined during last three years. Rather, there is increasing trend in the performances of KVI sector during last three years. The details of the same is as follows:

(b): Yes sir, Government has taken steps to promote khadi and village industries through KVIC and provide financial assistance to artisans in rural and small towns during the last three years.

Under Khadi Vikas Yojana (KVY), component of KGVY Scheme, financial assistance to artisans is provided under Modified Market Development Assistance (MMDA) and Workshed Scheme for Khadi Artisans. The year-wise details of the same in Rajasthan is placed at **Annexure-I**.

Under Gramodyog Vikas Yojana (GVY), component of KGVY Scheme, skill development training and tool kit assistance is provided to rural artisans under various sub-components of GVY. The district-wise details of Rajasthan including Jhunjhunu district and year-wise details during the last 3 years is placed at **Annexure-II**.

Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) also organizes various training programmes like Skill Development Programme (SDP), Entrepreneurship Awareness Programme (EAP) and Entrepreneurship Development Programme (EDP) across India. The details of no. of candidate trained under SDP and EAP in Rajasthan State during last three years is as follows:

(c): KVI units are exporting their products directly or through merchant exporter agencies. Export of KVI Products during the last three years is given below:

- (d): The steps taken by the KVIC to promote export of KVI products is as follows:
 - i) Centre of Excellence for Khadi, with National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT) New Delhi have been set up for establishing benchmarked design processes for global standards, creating new fabrics and products, disseminating quality standards for fabrics, branding and publicity by creating interesting narratives around the new Khadi, creative visual merchandizing & packaging for new Khadi products.
 - ii) For protecting the identity of brand 'Khadi' globally, KVIC has secured registration for the Trademark 'Khadi' in 15 countries and secured registration for the Khadi Logo in 31 countries.
 - iii) Government has issued HS code bracket to categorize eleven KVI products in export.
 - iv) KVIC is participating in India International Trade Fair (IITF) organized by India Trade Promotion Organization (ITPO) at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi every year to showcase its products.
 - v) Participation in various International Exhibitions through prominent Export Promotion Agencies (EPCs) identified by the Govt. like ITPO, EPCH etc. regularly. In previous years, KVIC participated in World Trade Expo, Dubai, Spring Fair Birmingham, UK, India show Peru etc. whereby necessary exposure is provided to KVI products in overseas markets through B2B & B2C interactions.
