4554. DR. AMAR SINGH:

Will the MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the lack of large-scale industries in Fatehgarh Sahib and the challenges faced by MSMEs in the region and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether there is any proposal to establish industrial clusters or provide incentives for new industries to generate employment and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) and (b): Industry is a State subject and the Central Government supplements the efforts of the States/UTs through various schemes, programmes and policy initiatives for promotion, development of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the country. The Government implements various Central Sector and demand driven schemes, programmes for MSMEs in the country including Fatehgarh Sahib in Punjab. These schemes/ programmes include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme(PMEGP), Credit Guarantee Scheme(CGS) for Micro and Small Enterprises, PM Vishwakarma, Micro and Small Enterprises -Cluster Development Programme(MSE-CDP), Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance(RAMP), MSME Champions Scheme, etc.

(i) Under National Industrial Corridor Development Programme (NICDP), as part of the Amritsar Kolkata Industrial Corridor (AKIC), an integrated Manufacturing Cluster (IMC) Rajpura-Patiala(1,098.85 acre) in the State of Punjab was approved by Government of India in August, 2024 with an estimated project cost of Rs. 1367.72 Crore.

- (ii) For providing ease of access to finance, in addition to CGS, Schemes, such as, Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) for setting up of new micro enterprises in the non-farm sector by providing Margin Money subsidy on the Bank loan, Special Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme with a provision of 25% subsidy to SC/ST MSEs on institutional finance for procurement of Plant & Machinery/Equipment.
- (iii) Details of PMEGP performance in the district of Fatehgarh Sahib, in terms of number of units assisted, Margin Money (MM) subsidy disbursed and estimated employment generated in the last 3 years, i.e., FY 2021-22 to FY 2023-24 is given below:
