#### NO. 4562. SHRI APPALANAIDU KALISETTI:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of the National Urban Digital Mission (NUDM) along with its implementation across the country, State-wise, particularly in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated and utilized under NUDM during the last three years and the current year, State-wise;
- (c) the key digital governance initiatives and infrastructure developed under NUDM to enhance urban service delivery;
- (d) whether the Government has assessed the impact of NUDM on Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in terms of efficiency, transparency and citizen services and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to integrate NUDM with other urban missions such as the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) and AMRUT along with the future expansion plans for the initiative, if any?

(a) to (e) The Scheme of National Urban Digital Mission (NUDM) for the period 2025-29 is under consideration. Budget Estimate for the year 2024-25 ₹1150.02 crore. However, in pursuance of the fund flow guidelines of Ministry of Finance, the fund at Revised Estimate stage was requested to be reduced from ₹1150.02 crore to ₹108.70 crore. The Urban Platform for DeliverY of Online Governance (UPYOG) Portal is being developed as a proof of concept for urban service delivery and its full rollout will occur during the Mission Period post-implementation.
