INCREASE IN MINIMUM SUPPORT PRICE

4873. SHRI K RADHAKRISHNAN:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the decisions taken by the Government in the interest of farmers;
- (b) the number of times the Minimum Support Price (MSP) has been increased during the last three years and the amount by which it was increased, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether any new schemes are being formulated to increase MSP, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण राज्य मंत्री (SHRI RAM NATH THAKUR)

- (a): Government has taken several steps like policy reforms, developmental programmes and schemes for making agriculture, sustainable and more profitable profession. List of major schemes being implemented by the Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare in the interest of farmers is given in the **Annexure I**.
- (b) & (c): Every year, Government fixes Minimum Support Price (MSP) for 22 mandated agricultural crops based on the recommendations of Commission for Agricultural Costs & Prices (CACP), after considering the views of State Governments and Central Ministries/Departments concerned. The Union Budget for 2018-19 had announced the predetermined principle to keep MSPs at levels of one and half times of the cost of production. Accordingly, Government had increased MSPs for all mandated Kharif, Rabi and other Commercial crops with a minimum return of 50 percent over all India weighted average cost of production from year 2018-19 onwards. The details of MSP (marketing Season-wise) fixed by the Government during last three years is given at **Annexure II**.
