(a)to (c): Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) is a demand driven wage employment Scheme which provides for the enhancement of livelihood security of the households in rural areas of the country by providing at least one hundred days of guaranteed wage employment in every financial year to every household whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work. It provides livelihood security, i.e. fall back options for livelihood for the rural households, when no better employment opportunity is available.

The details of the funds released and person-days generated under the Mahatma Gandhi NREGS in the Union Territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli for the last five financial years, from 2020-21 to 2024-25, are given below:
