Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING be pleased to state:

- (a) the financial allocation made for the various schemes of the Government such as Aquatic Health Management and the amount spent as of February 2025, State-wise, particularly Uttarakhand and Odisha:
- (b) the number of projects that have been approved under the scheme as of February 2025 and the financial worth of the projects State-wise, particularly Uttarakhand and Odisha;
- (c) the equipment and facilities provided for inland fisheries under the scheme as of February 2025 State-wise, particularly Uttarakhand and Odisha; and
- (d) whether the Ministry has taken steps for aquatic health management and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (SHRI GEORGE KURIAN)

(a) to (d): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India with effect from the financial year 2020-21 has been implementing a flagship scheme the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) in all States and Union Territories for holistic development of fisheries and aquaculture sector in the country. Based on receipt of viable proposals, the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying during the last four years (2020-21 to 2023-24) and current year(2024-25) has accorded approvals to the fisheries developmental proposals of various State Governments, Union Territories and other implementation agencies amounting to Rs.20,990.79 crore with central share of Rs.8926.28 crore under the PMMSY. This includes the project worth of Rs322.97 crore for Government of Uttarakhand and Rs1138.68 crore for Odisha. Development of aquaculture is one of the thrust areas supported under PMMSY for expansion of aquaculture area, intensification, diversification and productive utilization of land and water, quality inputs, infusion of technology, post-harvest management and strengthening of value chain. The key interventions projects/activities approved under PMMSY for development of aquaculture include; 32051 hectares of aquaculture area, 895 hatcheries, 25 Brood Banks, 12081 Re-circulatory Aquaculture Systems, 4205 biofloc units, 55118 reservoir cages and 5711 raceways and 560.7 hectares pens in reservoirs, 3882 hectares of freshwater biofloc pond area. State-wise details of projects approved and central fund released under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana during the last four years and current year are furnished at Annexure-I.

The PMMSY inter-alia focuses aquatic animal health management activities to addresses the emergence of new and trans-boundary aquatic diseases especially in aquaculture and aquatic health management projects with an investment of Rs 49.50 crore have been approved during the last four years and current year including the aquatic health management project of Rs 2.40 crore approved for Odisha under this scheme. State/UT-wise details of the Aquatic Health Management projects approved under PMMSY during last four years and current year are furnished at Annexure -II.
