Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and total number of unskilled rural youth, both men and women, in the country;
- (b) the details of schemes available to impart skill development for rural youth and the amount allocated during the last three years; and
- (c) the total number of rural youth, both men and women, were skilled and given jobs during the such period?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN)

- (a): The details and total number of unskilled rural youth, including men and women in the country is not maintained.
- (b) & (c): Ministry is implementing the following two schemes in the field of skill development for rural poor youth under the umbrella scheme of DeendayalAntyodayaYojana - National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM):
- i. DeenDayalUpadhyayaGrameenKaushalyaYojana (DDU-GKY): DDU-GKY is a placement-linked skill development program for rural poor youth in the age group of 15-35 years. It empowers the rural poor youth with employable skills and facilitates their participation in regular labour markets, thus providing them with jobs having regular monthly wages at or above the minimum wages.

ii. Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs): RSETI is a Bank lead - MoRD funded training institution established by the Sponsoring Bank in their Districts, to provide training for Skill and Entrepreneurship Development to rural poor youth. MoRD extends financial support for the construction of RSETI building and also bears the cost of training of the rural poor candidates. Any unemployed youth in the age group of 18-45 years having an aptitude to take up self-employment or wage employment can undergo training at RSETI.
