(a)&(b): Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for 'Specialty Steel' was launched with an overall budget of Rs.6,322 crore in July, 2021 to promote the manufacturing of 'Specialty Steel' within the country and reduce imports by attracting capital investments. The current status of key indicators in PLI Scheme for specialty steel are as follows:-
