#### SOLAR ENERGY PROJECTS IN GUJARAT

## 5065. SHRI DHAVAL LAXMANBHAI PATEL

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of solar energy projects implemented under Pradhan Mantri-Kisan Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahabhiyan (PM-KUSUM) in Gujarat's panchayats along with other renewable energy initiatives and the specific districts where these projects have been deployed; and
- (b) whether any State-specific incentives have been provided to panchayats in Gujarat for adopting solar-powered public lighting, water pumping systems and microgrids and if so, the details of such financial incentives?

(a) The PM KUSUM is a demand driven scheme and is being implemented in all states, including the State of Gujarat. Based on the demand received, the allocation and installation for Gujarat, as on 28.03.2025, is as follows:

As reported by the SIAs, the district wise installation under PM KUSUM scheme is placed at **Annexure I**.

(b) As reported by the SIA, no state specific financial incentives have been provided to panchayats in Gujarat for adopting solar powered public lighting, water pumping systems or microgrids.

However, state subsidy is provided to individual beneficiaries under Component B of the PM KUSUM, as follows:

- General Area: 30% state share apart from 30% central share
- Tribal area: 70% state share apart from 30% central share.
