Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the total number of Aspirational Blocks identified in Andhra Pradesh under the Aspirational Blocks Programme (ABP) till date, district-wise;
- (b) the funds sanctioned, released and utilized for these blocks since the inception of the programme, district-wise;
- (c) the progress achieved in Andhra Pradesh under the five key focus sectors of ABP along with the measurable outcomes, impact assessments and improvements recorded so far, blockwise;
- (d) the specific steps taken/being taken by the Government to accelerate development in underperforming blocks, ensure equitable resource allocation and address key challenges faced in implementation; and
- (e) whether the Government is considering the inclusion of additional blocks from Andhra Pradesh under ABP especially Anantapur district, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) There are 15 Aspirational Blocks across 7 districts from Andhra Pradesh under the Aspirational Blocks Programme (ABP). The district-wise list of Aspirational Blocks in Andhra Pradesh is provided in Annexure I.

- (b) The district-wise details of funds sanctioned, released, and utilized by Aspirational Blocks of Andhra Pradesh under ABP are provided in Annexure II.
- (c) The Aspirational Blocks Programme is essentially a template for improving governance. The programme monitors all Aspirational Blocks on a quarterly basis across 40 Key Performance Indicators (KPIs). These indicators fall under crucial sectors of Health & Nutrition, Education, Agriculture & Allied Sectors, Social Development, and Basic Infrastructure. The progress of all 500 Aspirational Blocks on all indicators is monitored and the performance data is publicly accessible via the Champions of Change Dashboard (https://abp.championsofchange.gov.in/).
- (d) The programme focuses on effective convergence of existing Central and State Government schemes through collaboration among the Centre, State, District Administration, and citizens, without a large infusion of additional funds. The progress of all 500 blocks is monitored quarterly through a Delta Ranking method based on improvements in the 40 KPIs.
- (e) The Aspirational Blocks Programme covers 500 blocks across India. Currently, there is no proposal under consideration to extend the Aspirational Blocks Programme beyond 500 blocks.
