**PM-JANMAN SCHEME IN ANDHRA PRADESH AND WEST BENGAL**

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has undertaken any recent survey or study regarding the progress and implementation of the PM-JANMAN scheme during the last five years and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of the projects proposed, approved and presently implemented under the said scheme across the country, component-wise and State-wise, particularly district-wise in Andhra Pradesh including Prakasam and Eluru districts;
- (c) the details of the total funds allocated, released and utilized during the last five years across the country, State-wise, particularly district-wise in Andhra Pradesh including Prakasam and Eluru districts;
- (d) the details of the total number of beneficiaries, including youth and women, benefitted from the said scheme during the last five years across the country, component-wise and State-wise, particularly district-wise in Andhra Pradesh including Prakasam and Eluru districts;
- (e) whether the Government has undertaken any campaign to raise awareness regarding the said scheme and projects thereunder and if so, the details thereof, especially in Andhra Pradesh;
- (f) whether the PM-JANMAN scheme is being implemented in West Bengal and if so, the details and objectives thereof; and
- (g) the current status of the said scheme along with the expected number of beneficiaries in West Bengal?

**ANSWER**

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS  
(SHRI DURGADAS UIKEY):

**(a) & (d):** On 15th November 2023, Hon'ble Prime Minister launched Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha AbhiyaN (PM JANMAN) for socio-economic development of 75 PVTG communities residing in 18 states and one UT. PM JANMAN is being implemented since 16 months and no recent survey or study regarding the progress and implementation of PM JANMAN has been undertaken. However, Ministry of Tribal Affairs through the State Governments/ UT Administration/departments has undertaken habitation level data collection exercise through PM Gati Shakti mobile application to estimate PVTG population figures and infrastructure gaps in order to cover PVTG population residing in villages & habitations covered under PM JANMAN. Based on the data captured (as on 28.02.2025), State/UT- wise, PVTG population is tabulated at **Annexure-I**. However, the actual number beneficiaries to be covered under these Abhiyans is subject to eligibility criteria of specific guidelines of concerned interventions as per approved norms.

**(b) & (c):** The objectives of PM JANMAN are being met through 11 interventions implemented by 9-line Ministries. The details of projects /interventions targeted under the scheme are at **Annexure II**. The details of progress of projects under the abhiyan, State-wise are given at **Annexure-III** and the district-wise progress in Andhra Pradesh including Prakasam and Eluru districts under the abhiyan is given at **Annexure-IV**. The details of financial sanctions, State-wise, are given in **Annexure-V**.

**(e)** In coordination with State Governments including Andhra Pradesh, IEC camps have been organized which were aimed at awareness generation and facilitating in preparation of basic documents like Aadhar Card, Caste

certificate, Jan Dhan bank account which are required for availing benefits under different schemes including Ayushman Card, PM Awas, MNREGA etc.

**(f) & (g)** As per information from line Ministries/Departments, no progress has been observed under the abhiyan in respect of interventions of housing (PMAY-G), roads (PMGSY), anganwadis and hostels (Samagra Siksha) in the State of West Bengal. The mission is approved for a period of three years. Ministry of Tribal Affairs has been regularly taking up the issue of implementation of activities( including for interventions of Ministry of Tribal Affairs) under Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM JANMAN) with State Government of West Bengal. Based on the data captured (as updated in October 2024), PVTG population, in the State of West Bengal is 67431.
