5367 SHRI BASTIPATI NAGARAJU: SHRI B K PARTHASARATHI:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of proposals received and approved under the Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS) during the last five years, year and State-wise;

(b) the details of the funds demanded and approved under the said scheme during the said period, year and State-wise;

(c) the details of funds sanctioned and disbursed for the approved projects during the said period, year and State-wise including district-wise for Andhra Pradesh; and

(d) the details of the physical progress of the approved projects along with the number of beneficiaries and the physical targets achieved in this regard in Andhra Pradesh, project-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI DURGADAS UIKEY)

(a) to (c): During 2021-22, the Government had revamped the earlier 'SCA to TSS' scheme and launched 'Pradhan Mantri Adi Adarsh Gram Yojna (PMAAGY)'. The details of state wise funds approved and released under the scheme of Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme (SCA to TSS) during the year 2020-21 is at **annexure I**. The scheme of PMAAGY which was implementated during 2021-22 to 2025-26, aimed at integrated development of 36,428 villages with at least 50% tribal population and this included 517 tribal villages of Andhra Pradesh. The details of the funds released to the states during 2021-22 to 2024-25 under the scheme of PMAAGY' is at **Annexure II**, However as Andhra Pradesh did not submit the Village Development Plans (VDPs) under the schem and hence funds could not be released. The schem guidelines prescribed for the monitoring of physical progress by the state governmets concerned and submit utilization certificates to the central government.

(d) As per the Scheme guidelines, the State Tribal Department being the nodal department coordinate the progress of various schemes / programmes and make monitoring with well-defined indicators, covering fund allocation, release and expenditure, service delivery standards as well as outcomes. Further the details of the approved projects along with the number of beneficiaries in Andhra Pradesh under the scheme of SCA to TSS during the year 2020-21 is at **annexure III**.
