WATER AND SEWAGE TREATMENT CAPACITY ACHIEVED UNDER AMRUT

**NO. 5417. SHRI VIJAY BAGHEL:
 MS. BANSURI SWARAJ:**

Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the water and sewage treatment capacity achieved under AMRUT in urban areas across the country, State-wise, particularly in Chhattisgarh;**
- (b) the number of projects approved by the Government under AMRUT 2.0, State-wise, particularly district-wise in Chhattisgarh including Durg Parliamentary Constituency; and**
- (c) the details of the total financial cost including operation and maintenance costs of the said projects approved under AMRUT 2.0?**

ANSWER

(a): Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) is implementing Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT), which was launched on 25 June 2015 in selected 500 cities (now 485 cities including 15 merged cities) and towns across the country.

Under AMRUT, 4,734 Million Litre per Day (MLD) water treatment plant (WTP) capacity and 4,447 MLD sewage treatment plant (STP) capacity have been created of which 317 MLD WTP capacity and 263.2 MLD STP capacity has been created in the State of Chhattisgarh. The State-wise details of WTP and STP capacity, including Chhattisgarh, is given in Annexure-I.

(b) & (c): AMRUT 2.0 has been launched on 01 October, 2021 in all Urban Local Bodies (ULBs)/ cities. Under AMRUT 2.0, States/ UTs are empowered to select, prioritise, design, implement and monitor the projects within the broad framework of Mission guidelines. So far, under AMRUT 2.0, a total of 8,868 projects worth ₹1,89,087.31 crore (including Operations & Maintenance cost) have been approved by MoHUA. State-wise details of approved projects is given in Annexure-II.

Under AMRUT 2.0, 76 projects worth ₹3,308.19 crore (including Operations & Maintenance cost) have been approved so far by MoHUA in Chhattisgarh of which 09 projects worth ₹641.58 crore have been approved in Durg Parliamentary Constituency (Bemetara and Durg district). District wise details of approved projects in Chhattisgarh is given in Annexure-III.
