### Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of dispensaries and health centres projects under Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) undertaken in the country, State-wise particularly in Parbhani Parliamentary Constituency of Maharashtra,
- (b) whether the Government proposes to set up more CGHS Centres in the country and if so, the details thereof, State/district-wise including Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra particularly in Parbhani Parliamentary Constituency and Osmanabad aspirational district and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the criteria prescribed for selection of cities for setting up dispensaries and health centres under Central Government Health Scheme;
- (d) the names of the States where CGHS health centres have been set up during the last three years in the country, State/district-wise and location-wise particularly in Maharashtra, and
- (e) the number of beneficiaries registered at the above said centres along with the number of serving employees and pensioners benefited therefrom?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI PRATAP RAO JADHAV)

(a) to (e): The details of CGHS Wellness Centres, State-wise, is at **Annexure-I**. The extant norms for opening of a new CGHS Wellness Centre, *inter-alia*, include minimum 2500 principal CGHS Cardholders or 6000 CGHS beneficiaries subject to availability of resources, suitable accommodations, creation of posts of Medical Officers, Pharmacists, Staff Nurse, Clerical Staff *etc*. The sanction of posts and allocation of funds for these Wellness Centres is under the ambit of Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance.

The details of CGHS Wellness Centres, District-wise & Location-wise along with number of CGHS beneficiaries, opened during last 03 years, is at **Annexure-II**.
