PROGRESS UNDER SFURTI

555. DR. BYREDDY SHABARI: SHRI G LAKSHMINARAYANA: SHRI KRISHNA PRASAD TENNETI:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) the details of number of clusters approved, functional/operational, pending clearance and yet to commence including handloom clusters under the Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI) along with their status across the country during the last five years, State/UT and district-wise in Andhra Pradesh including Nandyal, Anantapur and Bapatla Parliamentary Constituencies;

(b) whether the Government has identified reasons for delays in operationalizing clusters in the various States including Andhra Pradesh and if so, the steps being taken to address these delays;

(c) the total funds allocated, released and utilized under the SFURTI scheme in the country, State, district-wise in Andhra Pradesh including the said Parliamentary Constituencies during the last five years;

(d) whether the Government is planning to expand the coverage of the SFURTI scheme to include more traditional industries and crafts, particularly in underserved regions like Rayalaseema and north coastal Andhra Pradesh and if so, the details thereof;

(e) the details regarding the total number of individuals, especially women and youth, who have been benefited by the SFURTI scheme during the last five years across the country, State-wise, district-wise in Andhra Pradesh including the said Parliamentary Constituencies; and

(f) the details regarding the total number of jobs generated and MSME clusters grown under the SFURTI scheme during the last five years, State-wise, district-wise in Andhra Pradesh including the said Parliamentary Constituencies?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

(a): The continuation of Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI) is awaiting approval beyond 30.09.2022 as such any new proposals are not being approved. Details of clusters approved, became functional/operational, including handloom clusters, along with their status across the country during the last five years, State/UT wise and District-wise in Andhra Pradesh are annexed as Annexure-I.

(b): Yes, the reasons for delay in the operationalization of the clusters have been identified by the Government and various steps, including regular follow up with the stakeholders w.r.t physical and financial performance, have been taken up to address the delay in operationalization of the clusters.

(c): The consolidated fund is approved under SFURTI as such the funds are not allocated or released State wise or District.

(d): No Sir. The continuation of SFURTI is awaiting approval beyond 30.09.2022 and the Government does not have any plan to include more traditional sectors and crafts.

(e): Around 116,836 women artisans have been directly benefitted under SFURTI during the last five years. State wise details and District-wise details of Andhra Pradesh, are annexed as Annexure-I.

(f): The details regarding the total number of jobs generated and clusters approved under SFURTI during the last five years in State wise and District-wise in Andhra Pradesh are annexed as Annexure-II.
