**State Annual Action Plan in Chhattisgarh**

†5591. Shri Vijay Baghel:

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount of fund released for State Annual Action Plan for health sector in the State of Chhattisgarh from year 2014-15 to till date;
- (b) the total number of AYUSH hospitals and AYUSH dispensaries sanctioned by the Government in Chhattisgarh from 2014-15 to till date; and
- (c) the total number of sanctioned AYUSH villages from year 2014-15 to till date in the country, State/UT-wise including district-wise particularly in Durg Parliamentary Constituency of Chhattisgarh?

**ANSWER**

- (a) As per the proposals received through State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) from the State Government of Chhattisgarh under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM) from year 2014-15 to till date, Ministry of Ayush has released an amount of Rs. 139.36 crore for implementation of different approved activities.
- (b) Public Health being a State subject, setting up of Ayush hospitals and Ayush dispensaries, comes under the purview of respective State/UT Governments. However, under NAM, there is provision of financial assistance to States/UTs including Chhattisgarh for setting up of 50/30/10 bedded integrated Ayush hospitals and establishment of new Ayush dispensaries in the area where there are no Ayush facilities available. Accordingly, as per the proposals received from State Government of Chhattisgarh through SAAPs, 13 units of Integrated Ayush Hospitals and 6 units of Ayush Dispensaries have been approved for establishment.
- (c) Ayush Gram is a concept wherein villages are selected for adoption of principles and practice of Ayush way of life and interventions of health care. As per NAM guideline, there

is a provision of financial assistance of Rs. 3.0 lakhs per unit covering 2000-3000 population in 2-3 villages in a block. As per the proposals received by the States/UTs through SAAPs, 1494 number of Ayush Gram units has been supported under Ayush Gram in the country from year 2014-15 to 2024-25 but district-wise data is not being maintained in the Ministry. Further, as reported by State Government of Chhattisgarh three villages of Durg constituency have been approved under Ayush Gram unit in SAAP 2024-25 as proposed by State Government of Chhattisgarh. The State/UT-wise status of approved Ayush grams is furnished at **Annexure**.
