**Funds for Development of SAI and NCOE**

**†55. Shri Satpal Brahamchari :**

**Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:**

**(a) the total amount of funds allocated by the Union Government for the development of Sports Authority of India (SAI) and National Centre of Excellence (NCOE) located in Sonipat Parliamentary Constituency of Haryana till January 2025 along with the details thereof;**

**(b) the manner in which the management process stipulated for the supervision of SAI and NCOE along with the details thereof;**

**(c) whether there is any provision in place for providing monthly assistance to athletes under any scheme in Haryana; and**

**(d) if so, the details thereof?**

**ANSWER

**(a) and (b) : The total funds allocated by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports to Sports Authority of India (SAI) is ₹805.00 crore in the current financial year out of which funds of ₹53.62 crore have been released by Sports Authority of India to its Regional Centre in Sonipat. The Government does not allocate funds directly to National Centre of Excellence (NCOE).**

**The day to day operations of a NCOE under SAI are managed by a Chief Operating Officer (COO) who reports to Chief Executive Officer**

**(CEO), Regional Head. The NCOEs further report to Talent Identification and Development Committee (TIDC) and Operations Division at SAI Head Office at New Delhi. Each discipline at NCOE has a designated High Performance Director (HPD) and High Performance Manager (HPM) who monitor the performance of athletes in coordination with the Regional Centres.**

**(c) and (d): Athletes including those from the State of Haryana, are provided assistance under various sports promotional schemes run by SAI. The selected athletes are provided financial support in the form of expert coaches, sports equipment, boarding and lodging, sports kit, competition exposure, educational expenses, medical/insurance as per the approved scheme norms.**

**Further, under the Khelo India program, comprehensive support is provided to athletes in the form of scholarships, specialised training and coaching facilities, exposure to international competitions, and access to world-class training facilities, which entail funding of ₹6.28 lakh per annum per Khelo India Athlete (KIA) (including ₹10,000 per month out-of-pocket allowance for each KIA). The scheme wise norms are provided at Annexure.**
