- (a) whether the Government is proposing to reduce the physical test parameters between male and female candidates for recruitment in the Indian Army;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government believes that such a move will ensure a more inclusive environment for women in the Indian Army and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the manner in which the Government plans to maintain the overall operational efficiency and readiness of the Army while implementing these changes;
- (e) the details of measures proposed/being proposed by the Government to ensure that the physical standards for women candidates, if revised, remain consistent with the physical demands required by the Army in real combat scenarios; and
- (f) whether there are any concerns raised by military leadership or experts regarding the potential impact of reducing the physical test parameters on the performance and preparedness of female recruits and if so, the details thereof?
