Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of the Government/Private Nursing colleges in the country at present, State/UT-wise, district-wise including Warangal Parliamentary Constituency of Telangana;
- (b) the strength of paramedical staff in the country, State/UT-wise, district-wise including Warangal Parliamentary Constituency of Telangana;
- (c) whether the Government has set any standards of training for the paramedical staff and if so, the details thereof along with strength of adequately trained paramedical staff, State/UT-wise, district-wise including Warangal Parliamentary Constituency of Telangana; and
- (d) whether the Government has a target ratio of patient to paramedical staff to be achieved in the next five years and if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

- (a) As per the Indian Nursing Council (INC) records, the total number of the Government/Private nursing colleges in the country at present, state-wise, district-wise in Telangana and in Warangal Parliamentary constituency is at **annexure-II** respectively.
- (b) to (d) The National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Profession has been constituted vide notification dated 11.03.2024 under the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professions (NCAHP) Act, 2021 to regulate the education and services of the 57 allied and healthcare professionals; assessment and rating of all allied and healthcare institutions to ensure uniform standards and quality assurance; maintenance of live National and State Registers for registration of all allied and healthcare professionals. The commission has launched a portal on 29.10.2024 for enrollment of the existing professionals/institutions imparting services/education related to the 57 professions listed in the Schedule of the Act.
