NEW AIRPORT IN RAIGARH

be pleased to state:-

(a) whether the Government has proposed/is considering a new airport in Raigarh Lok Sabha Constituency of Chhattisgarh under UDAN Scheme; and (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (b): Regional Connectivity Scheme - Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik (RCS-UDAN) is a market-driven Scheme where bidding rounds are conducted from time to time to cover more destinations and routes. Based on their assessment of demand on particular routes, interested airlines submit their proposals connecting the Airports at the time of bidding under UDAN. In the first round of bidding under the scheme, Raigarh Airport was listed in RCS document for bidding.

The Airport owner, Jindal Steel and Power Limited (JS&PL) neither gave consent for developing the airport nor provided necessary concessions to the SAOs, which are required as per provisions of the scheme. Due to which, Raigarh airport was deleted from the list of unserved airports in the UDAN document for future bidding rounds.
