CASES OF FILARIAL HYDROCELE

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the number of patients suffering from filarial hydrocele infection in Baster Lok Sabha Constituency during the last year; and

(b) the reasons for spreading of the said disease along with the measures being taken by the Government to prevent it ?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a) and (b) As per the report submitted by the States/UTs to the National Center for Vector Borne Diseases Control (NCVBDC) of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, 28 patients were suffering from filarial hydrocele in Baster in 2023. Bastar is a newly mapped district under Lymphatic Filariasis (LF) program and has started with annual Mass Drug Administration (MDA) campaign from year 2024. It achieved MDA coverage of 92% against the estimated eligible population.

The Government of India has adopted the following 5-point strategy to prevent and treat the LF cases which are being implemented in all the LF endemic districts in the country including Baster:

(1) Mission Mode annual MDA.

(2) Morbidity management and disability prevention with focus on early diagnosis and treatment.

(3) Integrated vector control with multi sectoral coordinated efforts.

(4) High level advocacy with line ministries/departments and

(5) Leveraging existing digital platforms for LF and explore alternate diagnostics.
