# LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 926 TO BE ANSWERED ON 10.02.2025

#### **Development of Sustainable Wildlife and Forest Tourism**

926. SHRI NAVASKANI K: SHRI C N ANNADURAI:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing any scheme to promote wildlife and forest tourism in the country and if so, the details thereof alongwith the scope of the same in the State of Tamil Nadu;
- (b) the steps taken by the Government to tap the potential and promotion of the wildlife and forest tourism in the notified Tiger Reserves, National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries within the country including said State;
- (c) whether any scheme has been put in place to involve local communities as stakeholders in the development of sustainable wildlife and forest tourism; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the funds provided by the Government for promoting sustainable wildlife and forest tourism during the last three years, State/UT-wise including Tamil Nadu?

#### **ANSWER**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI KIRTI VARDHAN SINGH)

(a) to (d) The Ministry provides financial assistance to States/UTs for conservation of wildlife and its habitats including for undertaking eco-tourism activities under the Centrally Sponsored schemes – 'Development of Wildlife Habitats', 'Project Tiger and Elephant' including in the State of Tamil Nadu.

The tourism activities in and around tiger reserves are carried out as per the National Tiger Conservation Authority (Normative Standards for Tourism activities and Project Tiger) Guidelines, 2012 issued by the Ministry under section 38-O(1)(c) of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972.

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has also issued 'Guidelines for Sustainable Ecotourism in Forest and Wildlife Aeas-2021' which promotes the engagement of local communities in nature tourism in a manner that enriches local economy and encourages sustainable use of indigenous materials through financially viable values chains.

The details of financial assistance provided to States/Union Territories under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes – 'Development of Wildlife Habitat' and Project Tiger and Elephant' are placed at **Annexure I** and **Annexure II** respectively.
