Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether 76 projects with a total allocation of Rs. 5287.90 crores have been accorded sanction under the Swadesh Darshan Scheme (SDS) considering the overall impact on the tourism sector, local economy, infrastructure and employment, out of which 75 projects have been physically completed so far;
- (b) the details of the revamped version of the Swadesh Darshan 2.0;
- (c) whether any measures have been taken to ensure that the development of tourist destinations under the said scheme is in line with the principles of sustainability and responsible tourism;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the details of the allocation and utilization of Rs.793.20 crores sanctioned for 34 projects under the said Swadesh Darshan 2.0?

ANSWER

(a) to (e): Ministry of Tourism launched its Swadesh Darshan scheme in 2014-15 and sanctioned 76 projects in the country for ₹5287.90 crores under the identified thematic circuits for development of tourism in the country, considering the overall impact on the tourism sector, local economy, infrastructure and employment, out of which 75 projects are reported physically completed.

The Ministry of Tourism has revamped the Swadesh Darshan scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible tourism destinations in the country following a destination and tourist centric approach. SD2.0 recognizes that in order to minimize the negative impacts and maximise the positive impacts of tourism, sustainable and responsible tourism is the key and encourages adoption of principles of sustainable tourism including environmental sustainability, socio-cultural sustainability and economic sustainability. The scheme further encourages State Governments/UT Administrations to undertake due consultations with local communities and stakeholders, use of renewable energy, eco-friendly materials, development of accessible infrastructure and services, focus on capacity building, local entrepreneurship etc.
