- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including the Gujarat and Rajasthan;
- (c) whether ASI has included new monuments in the list for maintenance and restoration, if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Rajasthan;
- (d) whether any fund allocated for the repair and maintenance of monuments/forts located in Gujarat State during the last three years;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) the number of total monuments renovated during the last three years particularly in Rajasthan State?

- (a)to(c) Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) carries out regular survey of monuments, forts and other important buildings, including for the states of Gujarat and Rajasthan, to assess their historical, artistic, and archaeological importance. Monuments and archaeological sites and remains identified are declared as of national importance and are taken care by ASI including their conservation and maintenance. A list of monuments declared as of national importance during the last five years are at Annexure-I.
- (d)&(e) The fund allocated and spent for the repair and maintenance of monuments/forts located in Gujarat State during the last three years is as under:

(f) Conservation and preservation work of protected monuments is a continuous process and attended to regularly by the Archaeological Survey of India, as per need and priority considering the availability of funds and resources. Details are at Annexure-II.
