- (a) whether it is a fact that there is corruption in National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT);
- (b) whether it is also a fact that the activities of some officials of the NCLT are under probe by investigation agencies like CBI for corruption charges; and
- (c) whether an international agency like Transparency International in its report has also mentioned the charges about NCLT and if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard?
