SHORT TERM TRAINING UNDER PMKVY

1370. SHRI JAGADISH SHETTAR:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) the total number of candidates are benefitted under the Short Term Training Imparted at Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) in Karnataka by the Training Centres;
- (b) whether trained candidates provided Placement Assistance by Training Centres and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Taluka Panchayats conducting Kaushalya and Rozgar Melas every Six Months with Press/media Coverage; and
- (d) if so, the complete details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(a) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing its flagship Scheme Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) since 2015. Under PMKVY, skill training is imparted through Short Term Training (STT) and Re-skilling and Up-skilling through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to youth across the country.

As on 30th June 2025, a total of 6,05,147 candidates have been trained/oriented under PMKVY in the state of Karnataka.

(b) to (d) Placements were tracked in the Short-Term Training (STT) component in the first three versions of the Scheme which is PMKVY 1.0, PMKVY 2.0 and PMKVY 3.0 implemented from FY 2015-16 to FY 2021-22. Under these versions, a total of 74,225 candidates were reported placed in Karnataka. Under PMKVY 4.0, the focus is to empower our trained candidates to choose their varied career path and they are suitably oriented for the same. Under PMKVY, Rozgar Melas are being organized across the country in coordination with other stakeholders.

To enable the opportunities for employments, Skill India Digital Hub (SIDH) platform has been launched as a one-stop platform that integrates skilling, education, employment, and entrepreneurship ecosystems to provide a lifelong array of services targeting a wide range of stakeholders. Details of the trained candidates are available on SIDH platform for connecting with potential employers. Through Skill India Digital Hub, candidates can have access to jobs and apprenticeship opportunities
